In an effort to make A Community Table as accessible as possible, we have created brief tutorials on how to use two meeting platforms: Cisco Webex and Google Hangouts.

If you already have a preferred platform, use it! There are all kinds of ways to host A Community Table be it on the web or over the phone.

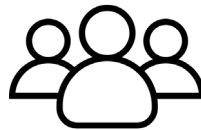
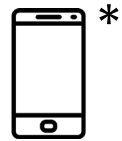
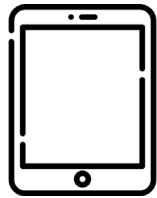

- To access the Hangouts app, visit <https://hangouts.google.com/> and sign in with your Gmail credentials

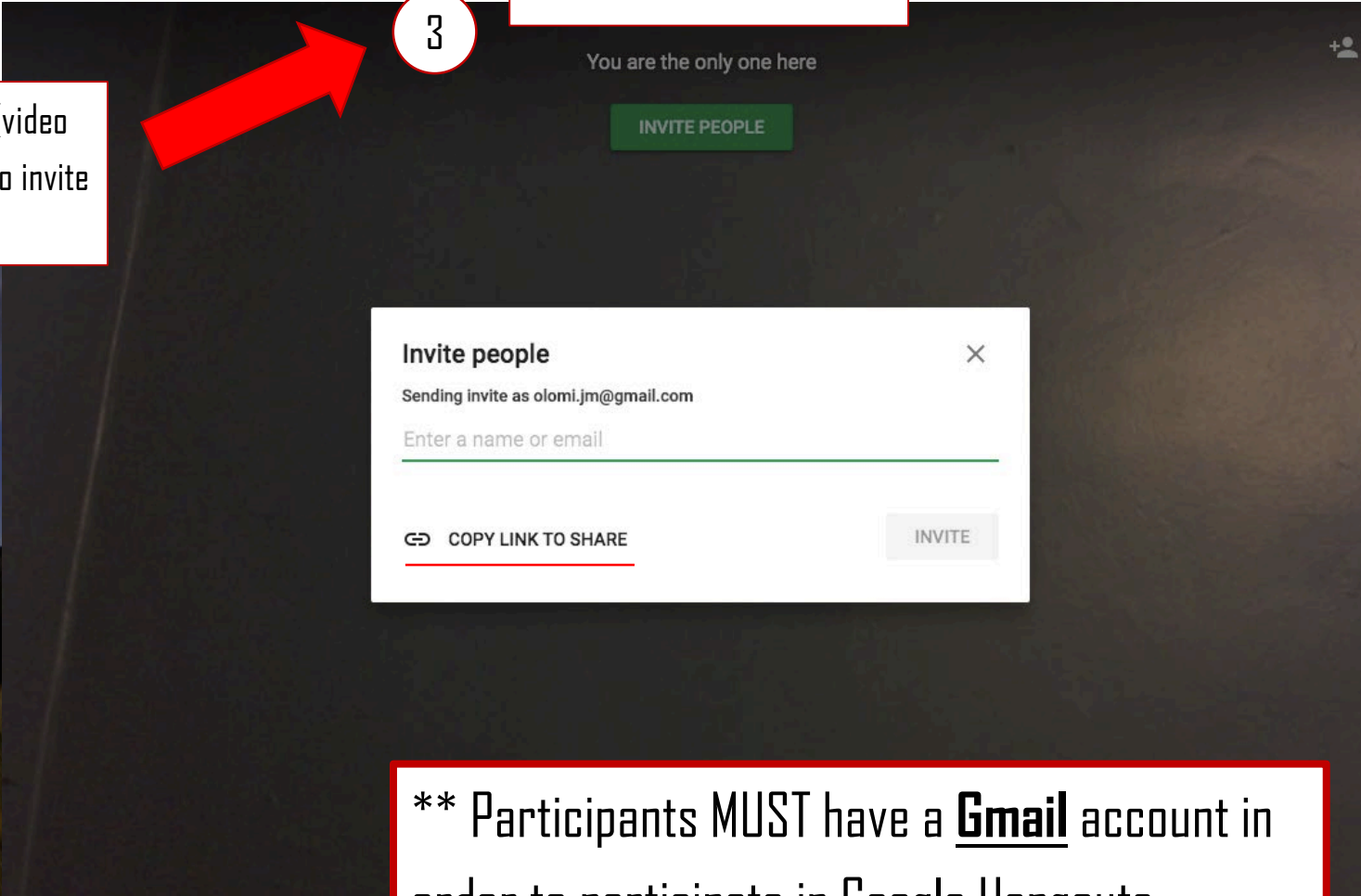


# Google Hangouts: Video calling

Starting the meeting (video call) will prompt you to invite participants



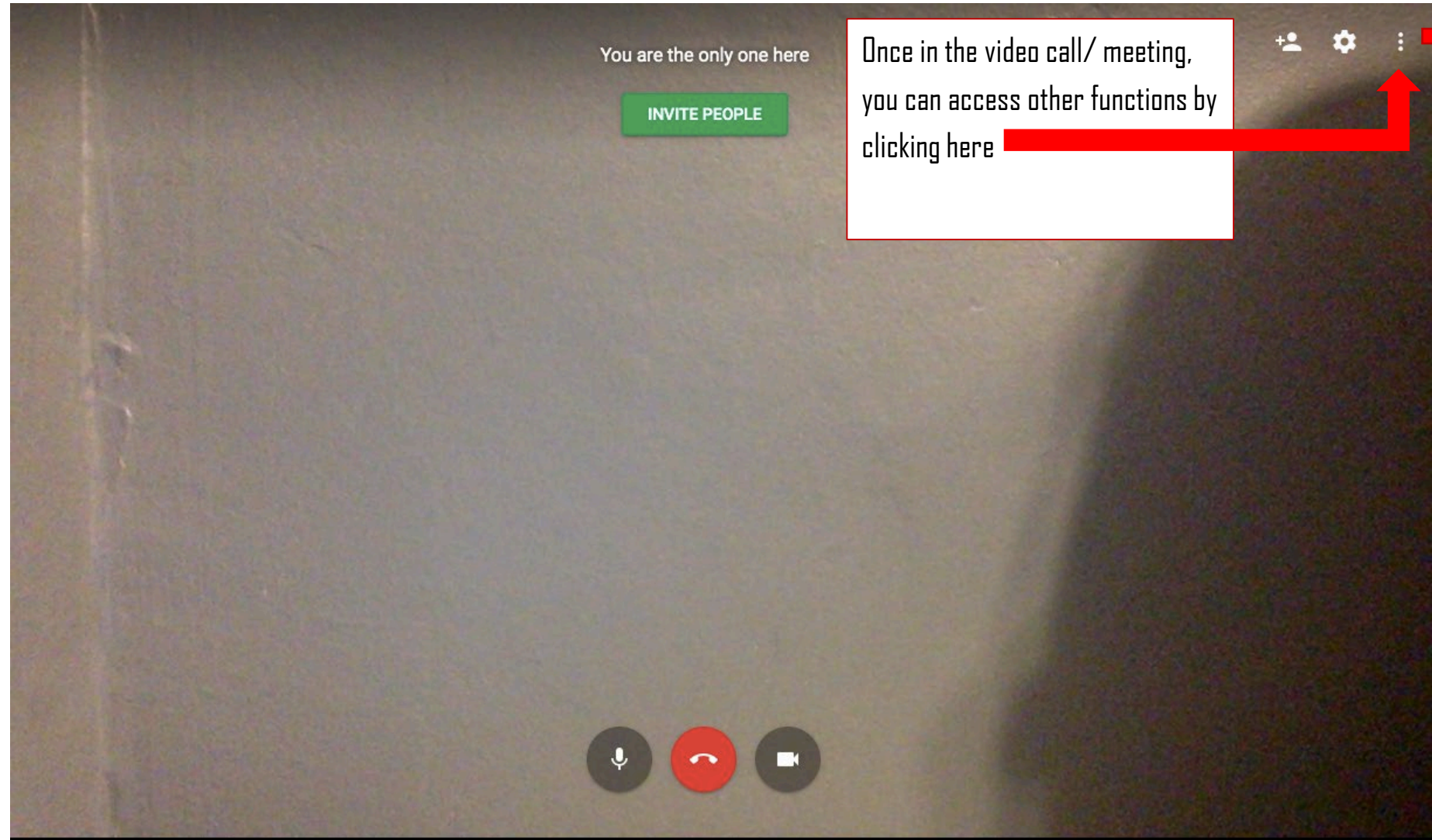
Enter GMAIL\*\* addresses of invited participants or send them the link

\*\* Participants MUST have a Gmail account in order to participate in Google Hangouts

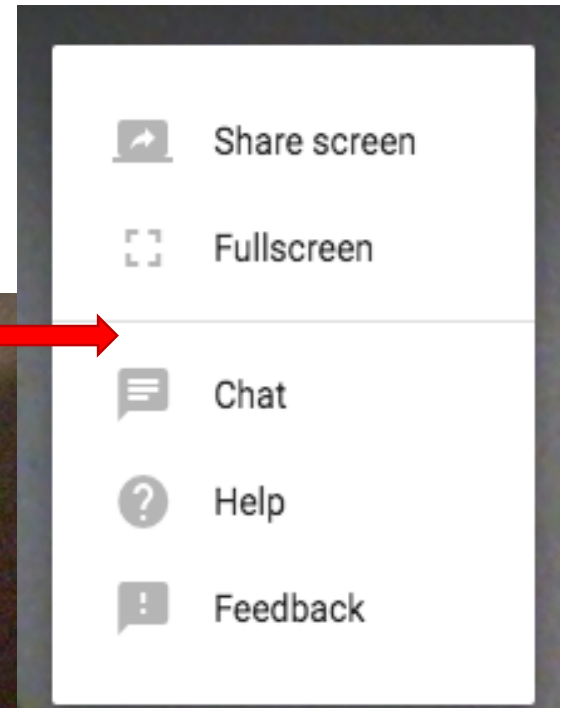
